WARNING

- During live fire, red/white flags are raised, red/white balloons or (at night) 3 red lamps forming a triangle are set up



1. Never touch

It is forbidden to touch in any way projectiles or ammunition pieces. Residual explosive ammunition may detonate even years afterwards and present a threat.



2. Mark

Whoever detects a projectile or ammunition pieces must mark their location well visibly. If possible, the area around the unexploded ordnance should be cordoned off and third parties should be kept at



Suspect findings can be reported at any time by dialling 117 (police), 058 481 44 44 (phone number of the National Unexploded Ordnance Reporting Centre) or with the UXO-App that can be found under the designation «Blindgänger» and downloaded free of charge.
